2018, Purple Ribbon Auction increases scholarships and awards by \$44,500

Nova-Tech buying group purchases Grand Champion Market Beef for \$18,000

Champion Purebred Market Hog brings \$6,500 for York, NE teenager

Grand Island, NE (October 22, 2018) – The Aksarben Stock Show managed and produced by Nebraska State Fair will award \$171,000 to the livestock showing youth as a result of the Purple Ribbon Auction. The 91st annual event was held September 27 – 30, 2018 at Fonner Park. Youth from eight of the 10 states showing qualified for the auction.

"This year we will distribute \$44,500 over the guarantee from the auction," explained Greg Harder, stock show director. "Our buying groups and sponsors are helping us reach our goal to grow and build on the history of Aksarben. We will continue to make this a fun and family orientated atmosphere where kids and families simply can't wait for the next year."

The Purple Ribbon Auction is the pinnacle event and open to the public. A reception is held prior to the auction for buyers to mingle with the youth exhibitors. Harder thanked the attendees and said, "I am humbled and honored to be in this position, now full circle since I last exhibited in 1981. I might be shedding a tear for my father, I wish he could be here to enjoy this auction too."

The grand champion market beef shown by Zachary Bradford from LaVerne, IA was purchased for \$18,000 by the buying group: Nova-Tech, MultiMin USA, HLG Packaging, Pathway Bank and Gideon Farms and Show Pigs.

Bradford is currently enrolled at Iowa Central Community College and studying welding. A second generation Aksarben Stock Show exhibitor Bradford said, "It is a blessing to get a scholarship. It makes it easier to go to school and not worry about money and be able to focus on my studies." His father, David, exhibited at Ak-Sar-Ben in the late 1980s and said the move to Grand Island with its outstanding facilities are reasons why they chose to include this show into their schedule.

Ninth grader, Hallie Hindman from Albia, IA took home the champion market lamb and it was purchased by Bank of the West for \$7,500. She plans to pursue a nursing degree. Her advice for others who are interested in showing is perseverance. "The harder you work, the greater you feel when you achieve it," she stated.

The champion market hog was shown by Sage Voegele from Lennox, SD and purchased for \$6,000 by the buying group: Midwest Chevrolet, Jerry's Sheet Metal, Home Federal Bank, Ag Services Inc. and Valmont. Voegele is a fifth grader with plans to attend the University of Nebraska and study preveterinary medicine.

Ten-year-old, Mason Rookstool from Wamego, KS showed the champion market goat. It was purchased by the Hoch family and Valmont for \$5,000. Rookstool plans to attend college and pursue a degree in animal science.

Kali Stratman from Cuming, NE, won the champion calf challenge prize. Her calf was purchased for \$11,500 by First National Bank of Omaha and Greg Baxter. Minnesotan Kaden Nelson from New Richland was awarded the champion lamb challenge, which sold for \$4,000 and was purchased by Kiewit.
